Application Fee

Capital Levy

Tuition Fees Inclusions

Tuition fees include most extra-curricular activities including sports, camps, incursions and excursions.

Sibling Discounts

Sibling discounts are applied on Tuition Fees if there are two or more students of one family attending the College concurrently. Sibling discounts are not applied on levies.

Payment Arrangements

College fees will be invoiced termly at two weeks before each term start. Fees are due and payable in full on the Friday of the first week of each term unless a direct debit arrangement is in place.

Paying Your Fees – Wisdom College has partnered with specialist provider Edstart to make managing your school fee payments easier.

To pay your College fees, please set up your account via the link that has been emailed to you or contact Edstart on 1300 139 445 for assistance.

Please Note:

- College Fees** DO NOT cover uniforms, students owned books, and stationery.
- IT Levy** DO NOT cover devices repairs.
- Camp Levy** is a compulsory component of the College Fee Schedule and is not subject to waiver.
- There may be additional charges** made for the year is the student chooses to study subjects such as Visual Art for which the materials/consumables are costly. This information will be provided at the time of subject selection.
- Private lessons** may be made available throughout a school year in activities such as Music, Speech and Drama. Payments for these lesson are arranged directly with the Tutor.
- Participation in some of the co-curricular activities** also attracts a fee. These fees vary depending upon the activity, with registration and payment completed per activity via the College's electronic payment system.
- Student withdrawals:** Where a parent or guardian wishes to withdraw a student from the College, for the current school term, the term College fee will be charged. For the following school term, no additional fee will be charged if the College is informed before the current school term finished. **The withdrawals notice is only accepted via email on enrolments@wisdom.qld.edu.au**
- Bad Debt Polity:** Legal action will be initiated to recover any outstanding fees. This includes lapsed direct debit payments, after which the debt may be transferred to a collection agency, and the family account could be listed as a credit default. Unpaid college fees may also impact the student's enrollment.
